

## Emergency Action Plans (Course 717)

### **Emergency Preparedness Training**

Several Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) standards explicitly require employers to have emergency action plans for their workplaces. Emergency preparedness is a well-known concept in protecting workers' safety and health. This course discusses the OSHA requirements detailed in 29 CFR 1910.38 (Emergency Action Plan) and is important for employers, managers, training directors, and other safety professionals.

5. **Review, Coordinate, and Update.**
