

Hazard Communication Program (Course 705)

HAZCOM Training

All employers must identify the hazardous chemicals they use and develop a hazard communication program (HAZCOM) to inform their employees about those chemicals. This course serves as an introduction to OSHA HAZCOM training, focusing on [Part 1910 Subpart Z - Toxic and Hazardous Substances - 1910.1200 Hazard Communication \(July 19, 2024\)](#). It incorporates the latest Global Harmonization Standards (GHS) and covers essential elements like written program requirements, labeling, safety data sheet (SDS) maintenance, and necessary training.

During the training **five (5) topics** will be discussed:

1. **General Responsibilities;**
2. **Analyzing the Workplace;**
3. **Container Labeling;** 4. **Safety Data Sheets;**
5. **Information and Training.**
