Oil and gas industry workers engage in many activities that may expose them to serious hazards, such as falling from towers, unguarded machinery, being struck by heavy equipment, electrocutions, and silica dust. This course is also an introduction to the basic elements of an effective Oil and Gas Industry Safety Management System (SMS).
